





Membership Matters

The Spring Affiliation Deadline for Educators Rising is **February 15, 2023**. All student members must be registered by this date in order to participate in local, state, and national Educators Rising events.

Students <u>competing</u> in competitive events and/or <u>attending</u> SLC are required to join Educators Rising.

If you experience difficulty with registering students, call Member Services at 800-766-1156 or email info@educatorsrising.org. Their membership associates are responsive and will be able to assist you.

Please allow 3-5 days for your account to be created and for payments to be credited to your school's member records.

Please note:

If you were contacted by the national Educators Rising office about an outstanding membership balance from the 2022 school year, your school will be required to pay the outstanding balance before members will be affiliated for the 2023 school year.

If these charges are there by error, contact Educators Rising Member Services.


Adding students to the Educators Rising membership database creates an obligation to pay the \$10 national dues regardless of their level of participation.
